

DSTO's capability analysis tool goes to market

Complex systems analysis work done by DSTO in support of major Army projects has resulted in the development and commercialisation of a tool designed for large-scale capability analysis.

DSTO has signed an agreement with Aerospace Concepts Pty Ltd of Canberra for commercialisation of the Systems Capability Assessment Model (Systems CAM) which was developed from work done with Weapons Systems Division on Army firepower projects from 2001 onwards. This agreement will allow

Aerospace Concepts to use the tool with clients in industry and overseas.

CWSD Warren Harch and Shaun Wilson, Managing Director of Aerospace Concepts, signed the agreement in Edinburgh on 3 October 2006.

The Systems CAM tool is designed to support capability analysis, concept definition, specification development, compliance assessment and source selection (tender evaluation) activities using a structured approach to system modelling.
